



Franklin Township Service Options

Option 1 (Standard Services with or without a trash cart)

- Maximum 4 32-gallon bags/cans provided by the resident collected 1x a week on Friday or 1 96-gallon trash cart provided by Republic Services at no additional charge collected 1x a week on Friday
- 1 64-gallon recycling cart provided by Republic Services for recycling collected 1x a week on Friday
- 1 large bulk item collected 1x a week on Friday. Residents must call **800.210.9675** to schedule bulk item pickup.

Quarterly price: \$97.50/quarter

Option 2 (Low-Volume Service)

- Residents pay by the tag for trash services; minimum purchase of 18 tags per year
- Low-volume customers will be mailed 18 tags at the start of each contract year
- 1 64-gallon recycling cart provided by Republic Services for recycling collected 1x a week on Friday
- 1 large bulk item collected 1x a week on Friday
- Cost: \$239.94/per year for 18 tags
- Any additional tags needed throughout the year may be purchased by calling Republic Services customer service at **800.210.9675**
- Cost for additional tags is \$13.33/bag

Bulk Items

Acceptable bulk items include carpet (48" max. length, rolled and tied), furniture, mattresses and box springs (must be wrapped), lawn mowers, grills, car tires (no rims), toilets, sinks, shower stalls, indoor bathtubs, interior doors and general household items and appliances.

Unacceptable bulk items include tractors, boats, vehicle parts (including truck caps), concrete, lawn and garden ornaments, railroad/landscaping ties, pianos, electronics (including TVs), computers and accessories, building materials, hot tubs/spas, riding mowers and outside structures, including fencing, gazebos and swing sets. **Residents must call 800.210.9675 to schedule bulk item pickup.**



Bottles and jugs
(#1, #2 and #5)



Cans
Aluminum and steel



Paper
Paper, junk mail and magazines
(clean and dry, no food contact)



Cardboard
Clean and dry,
no food contact



Glass
Bottles and jars



Cartons

- Unacceptable Materials
- Plastic bags
 - Food/liquid
 - Garden hoses
 - Shredded paper
 - Clothing/shoes
 - Diapers
 - Medical waste
 - Scrap metal
 - Polystyrene foam

All recycling and trash will be collected on Fridays.

Standard Service: 4 32-gallon carts or 1 96-gallon cart limit for trash once a week, 1 64-gallon cart for recycling once a week and one bulk item per week.

Low-Volume Waste: 18 tags per year, 1 64-gallon cart for recycling once a week and 1 bulk item per week.

Residents must call **800.210.9675** to schedule bulk item pickup.
