Call to Order

Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer

A Motion was made by Chairman Mark Wenrich to add Building Additions/Improvements, Sherwood Forest, Conditional Use Hearing 2022-1 Meeting Minutes of February 9, 2022, and Evans Driveway at 204 Chainsaw Road to the agenda.

By Pass Road Closure

Chairman Mark Wenrich publicly apologized to Naomi Decker, and she indicated she owed Chairman Wenrich an apology, also. Chairman Wenrich indicated that he cannot take any calls on his work phone and any calls should be to his cell phone for Township business.

Gibson-Thomas Engineer Todd Trabucco inspected the By Pass Road Bridge on March 22, 2022, determined it was unsafe to be used on March 23, 2022, and recommended it be closed on March 24, 2022. Engineer Todd Trabucco presented a power point presentation on why the bridge is unsafe and recommendations for fixing it. Discussion ensued.

Building Additions/Improvements

Supervisor Dave Buckwash indicated that the Township work conditions are not conducive to the population growth within the Township and our offices need to be enlarged to accommodate that growth. The BOS decided not to spend any more ARPA money until decisions are made regarding building additions/improvements. Discussion ensued. Engineer Phil Brath will present options and more information.
