Owner Nate Johnson indicated that he would like to build a 60 x 100 Agricultural Pole barn for storage of farm equipment and possibly later a few stalls to hold cattle. There will be no loft. The lot is 18 acres in the Open Space Zone. Zoning Officer Wayne Smith indicated that there are no problems with the setbacks. There will be no water or sewer but possibly electric in the future. The owner will need to contact Land & Sea Services for inspection of electric. Secretary Traci Kauffman stated that Land and Sea had Mr. Johnson sign a declaration that the building would be agricultural. There are no other buildings on the lot, but they currently have started to build their house.
