*Planning Commission members meet the second Tuesday of each month to review subdivision and land development plans for compliance with municipal regulations for land use, storm water, zoning, to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on the application. PC members also review existing township land use ordinances and make proposals for amending them to better serve the interests of the township and its residents. There is no prerequisite of formal training, but training is available through PSATS.

*The Zoning Hearing Board is responsible for ensuring fair and equitable application of the township zoning ordinance. The ZHB hears appeals of the Zoning Officer determinations and considers applications for special exceptions and variances. The ZHB meets the third Monday of each month, as needed, when an appeal or application is filed. There is no prerequisite of formal training, but training is available through PSATS.

*The Parks and Recreation Board meets the third Tuesday of each month, supervises, regulates and helps maintain township parks, and implements beautification of the parks. Periodic inspections are performed to determine future projects and needs. This Board coordinates organizational use, along with the Township Secretary, for soccer, baseball, softball, etc. of park facilities.
