RESOLUTION NO. 2023- 4

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND ADOPTING THE RATE OF TAX ON REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP FOR GENERAL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3205 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 68205, the Board of Supervisors may by resolution levy taxes upon all real property within the Township made taxable for Township purposes, as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes, for the purposes and at the rates specified in Section 3205; and

WHEREAS, in the absence of a petition to the Court of Common Pleas, an annual tax not exceeding fourteen mills may be levied for general township purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the Township of Franklin, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: The real estate tax rate for Franklin Township, York County, for the year 2024 and thereafter, until such time as the same is modified by subsequent resolution, shall be the sum of one and nineteen hundredths (1.19) mills on the assessed value of all real estate within said Township, the entire sum of which will be for general purposes.

Section 2: This Resolution is intended to and does commemorate that motion passed by the Board of Supervisors at its special meeting held March 13, 2023, increasing the millage for general township purposes from 0.60 mills for 2023 to 1.19 mills for 2024. For 2023, the millage for general township purposes remains the sum of sixty hundredths (0.60) mills.

Section 3: In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution or other Resolutions affected by this Resolution, it being the intent of Franklin Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.




Section 5: This Ordinance shall be immediately effective.



Effective in 2024, the Franklin Township Real Estate Millage will be increased to 1.19 mills. Resolution 2023-4, A Resolution Establishing and Adopting the Rate of Tax on Real Estate Within the Township for General Township Purposes was adopted on June 14, 2023.

Prior to the adoption of the resolution, discussions were held during monthly Board of Supervisor (BOS) meetings and at advertised BOS Workshop meetings on February 22, 2023, and March 13, 2023. A motion was made by the board at the March 13 meeting to increase the real estate tax by .59 mills with the funds dedicated solely for the use of the fire company effective in 2024 with the first real estate tax bill.
