*Planning Commission members meet once each month to review subdivision and land development plans for compliance with municipal regulations for land use, storm water, and zoning and then make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on the applications. PC members also review existing township land use ordinances and make proposals for amending them to better serve the interests of the township and its residents. There is no prerequisite of formal training.

*The **Zoning Hearing Board** is responsible for ensuring fair and equitable use of the township zoning ordinance. The ZHB hears appeals of zoning determinations and considers applications for special exceptions and variances. The ZHB meets only when an appeal or application is filed.

*The **Parks and Recreation Board** meets once each month, supervises and regulates township parks, and implements beautification of the parks. This Board coordinates organizational use (soccer, baseball, etc.) of park facilities.

*Board of Auditors members audit, settle, and adjust the accounts (if a private CPA firm is not designated) of all elected and appointed officials of the township. The BOA is not responsible for preparing the audit, which is prepared separately by a CPA firm. There is typically only one annual meeting of the BOA.
